#### MASKS ARE NOT REQUIRED **BUT STRONGLY SUGGESTED**



# **SEATING WILL BE EVERY** OTHER PEW AND A LIMITED NUMBER OF MEMBERS PER PEW.

Family's living together in the same household are encouraged to sit together to allow us to maximize the number of members in the sanctuary. Ushers will be available in the aisles to assist with these seating guidelines as we keep 6 feet between families. Please note beforehand that you may have to sit in an area of the church building that you are not accustomed to, we appreciate your understanding.





# THE CHURCH BULLETINS WILL **BE PLACED ON THE PEWS** PRIOR TO THE SERVICE.










### AT THE END OF THE SERVICE, **PEWS WILL BE DISMISSED IN A** PARTICULAR ORDER, SO AS TO **AVOID EVERYONE LEAVING AT** THE SAME TIME.

We will dismiss from the back to the front to adhere with the social distancing guidelines. Please wait until your pew is called to exit the sanctuary. Ushers will be available to assist members with a quick and smooth exit.





#### THERE WILL BE NO SUNDAY **SCHOOL OR CHILDREN'S** CHURCH AT THIS TIME.

Nursery facilities will be available to any parent needing them, but we ask that I parent, and I parent only attend to their child in the nursery and/or 3 & 4 year old classroom. There will be no nursery workers available so as to adhere to social distancing guidelines. Please hold to strict social distancing guidelines while in the nursery and be mindful if there are those waiting to use a changing station or other facility in the nursery. Please wipe down each surface that you may use with the wipes available in the nursery.





# OFFERING WILL BE COLLECTED **AT "STATIC" STATIONS NEAR EACH ENTRANCE.**

If you wish, you can place your offering in the offering plate as you enter or exit the sanctuary. We recommend that you take advantage of online giving, mailing your tithe to the church P.O.
